**Humber, Coast and Vale have kindly opened up their Men's health week to colleagues across North East and Yorkshire starting next week.**

#### **Men's Health Week**

We are now in Movember which is traditionally the month where we raise awareness of men's health issues and in Humber, Coast and Vale we want to play our part in supporting our male colleagues. We have a fantastic programme of events running throughout week commencing 8<sup>th</sup> November including. Here are some highlights:

- Men's sleep issues - do you or your male partner have difficulty sleeping? Snoring, sleep apnea, frequent interruptions to go to the toilet? If so, this session is for you and the man in your life (Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Nov 12-1pm and Friday 2-3pm)
- We will hear from Gareth Thomas, Welsh Rugby Player talking about LGBTQ+ equality, mental health and tackling stigma around HIV (Tues 9<sup>th</sup> Nov 2-3pm)
- There is a Q&A session with Dr Alex George. Alex works in A&E as an emergency doctor and has become a well-known and respected healthcare professional in the UK and will be talking to us about men's mental health and answer some your questions (Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Nov 10.30-11.30 with additional sessions looking at men's mental health on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> Nov 10.30-11.30)
- There are specific session on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> November for veterans to coincide with Remembrance Day

- We also have sessions during the week focusing on cancer, blood pressure, nutrition and exercise
