"We are currently based in Headingley (that might be changing soon!) but we

have gained funding to provide in person counselling within the Wakefield and Kirklees areas, and so are currently focussing in on these areas, to make sure, as a growing charity, that people are aware we are here, and what support we can offer people impacted in some way by a brain tumour, whether that is the patient themselves, their families or carers. Unfortunately our plans to support more people in the Wakefield area by establishing a therapy room in both Wakefield and Huddersfield continues to be restricted by covid, but we are hoping to be able to start offering the in person counselling, and perhaps a drop in/coffee morning very soon."
