WF Happy Healthy Holidays aims to keep children and young people active during the School Holidays by providing free enriching activities and healthy

food for children aged 5-16 who receive benefits-related free school meals.

Over the course of 2021, the DfE is grant funding Wakefield Council to coordinate free holiday provision which will cover four weeks in the summer and a week's worth of provision in each of the Easter and Christmas holidays in 2021.

Wakefield Council will fund, co-ordinate, and support local delivery by voluntary community organisations, schools and local authority teams. We will be looking to grant fund providers up to a maximum of £10k (larger projects may be considered) to deliver enriching activities and healthy food to eligible children over the Christmas school holidays.
